

**EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT FOR

I agree to hire CORBIN & ASSOCIATES, PC, ATTORNEYS as my attorney for the purpose of securing an Occupational License in Bell/Coryell County. I agree to pay to CORBIN & ASSOCIATES, PC, ATTORNEYS the sum of \$536.00 as attorney's fees for such legal services *in advance*.

I understand that the \$536.00 fee will include the filing fee of \$136.00 with the county clerk *and* the filing fee required by the Texas Department of Public Safety to record and issue the Occupational License.

I further understand that the \$536.00 fee ***does not include*** the \$125.00 reinstatement fee required by the Texas Department of Public Safety at the conclusion of my suspension. I further understand that it is my responsibility to pay this \$125.00 fee to DPS before I will receive my driver's license at the end of my suspension period.

I also understand that if I desire CORBIN & ASSOCIATES, PC, ATTORNEYS to forward the order to the Department of Public Safety to issue my license there will be an additional fee of \$10.00.

This is the entire agreement of the parties.
